Your kit contains 2 complete Anti-tip tube assemblies.

Tools needed: 5mm Hex key, 10mm wrench

A. REMOVE RUBBER CAPS 1 2

Wet the area under the rubber cap.

- a. Rotate and remove both caps(A) from the tubes.
- b. Dry off the area before inserting the anti-tips.

B. INSTALL THE ANTI-TIPS 3

Note: Before installation, adjust to shortest length.

- Push down on the Snap button(B) and insert the anti-tip into the lower rear frame tube, until the button pops out.
- b. Install the other anti-tip.

C. ADJUST THE ANTI-TIPS 4 5 6

Note: To prevent unintended tipping, the anti-tip wheel height should be adjusted 1.5 and 2" from the riding surface, both anti-tips must be the same height.

I. Adjust the anti-tip wheel length

- a. Push in the Snap button(C) and move the antitip wheels up or down. (see note)
- b If the wheels are still too high, adjust the angle.

2. Adjust the anti-tip angle

- a. Using a 10mm wrench and 5mm hex key Loosen screw (D) and remove bolt (E)
- b. Adjust the angle (see note). Re-insert the hardware and tighten for both sides
